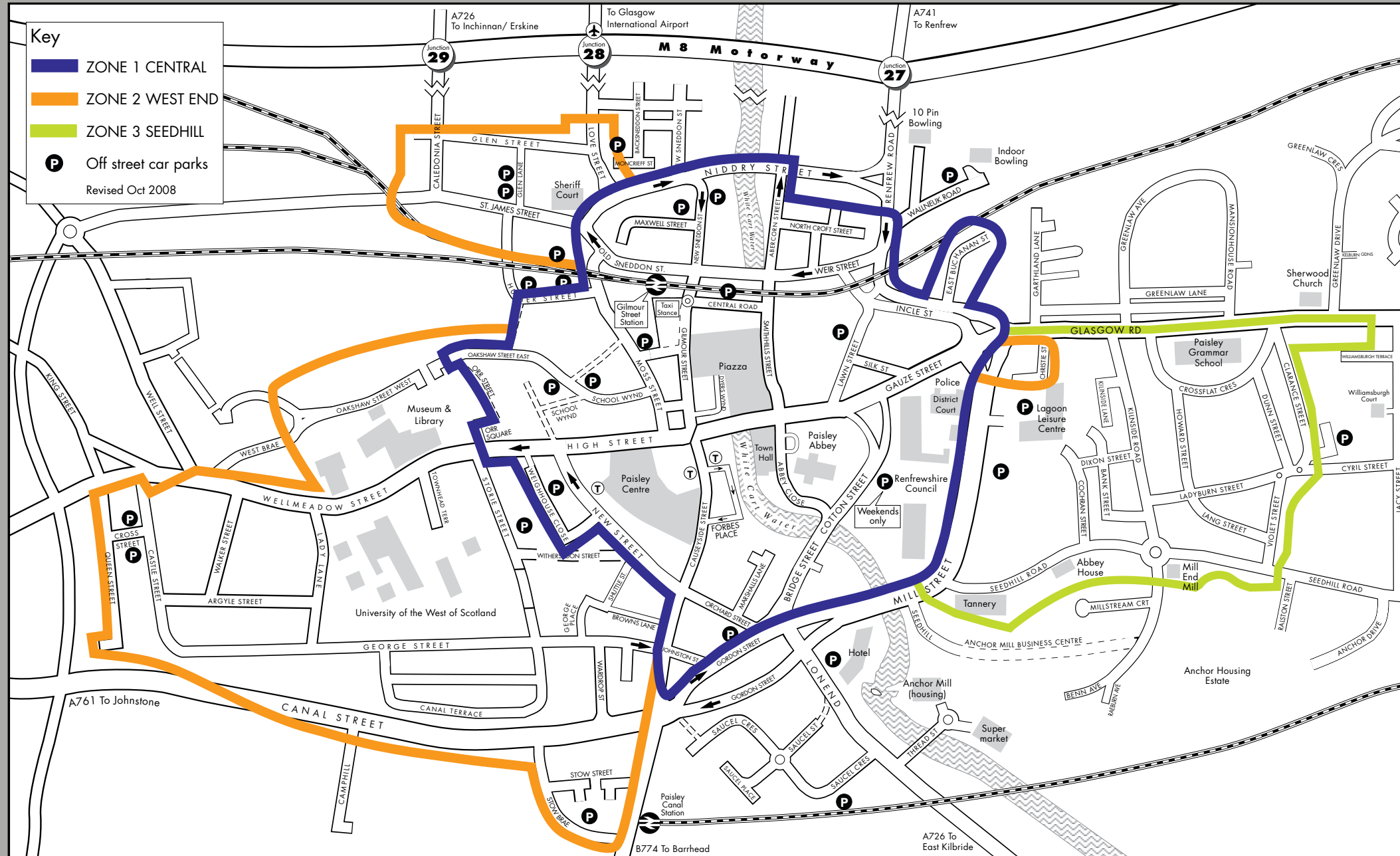


PAISLEY PARKING ZONES



PAISLEY RESIDENTS PARKING SCHEME



Residents parking permits are issued in Paisley to aid people to park their car near where they live. Historically as car ownership has grown, demand for the limited space has too. Demand in towns also outstrips available space when visitors and workers bring their cars. Paisley is no exception.

Parking permits are free to residents of the town who have cars (upon completion of an application form). Documentary proof of residence (voters roll, council tax or utility bill) and that the car is registered at the same address (DVLA form V5) is required. Company vehicles need a letter authorising use by the resident from the employer. If you don't yet have this a temporary 6 week permit will be issued until you do. The permits are not valid in car parks.
