

# **Renfrewshire Council**

## **(Various Roads, Shortroods area, Paisley) (Temporary Closures) Order 2011**

On the 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2011 the Renfrewshire Council made the above named Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (except for vehicles engaged in drainage operations for a new development) on the following lengths of road, by reason of works proposed to be executed on or near these roads. Indicative programmed phases are given below, but may vary slightly according to circumstances.

**Phase 1**, Closure: Fullarton Street (west half length), from Shortroods Road to Mossvale Nursery, 3<sup>rd</sup> September to 11<sup>th</sup> September.

**Phase 5**, Closure: Fullarton Street (west half length), from Mossvale Nursery to new Inchinnan Road: 2 weeks approximately.

**Phase 2**, 4 way signals: Fullerton Street at Galloway Avenue, 1 week approximately. Emergency vehicles on call would have the usual priority in passing other vehicles.

**Phase 3**, Closure: Shortroods Road, from Galloway Avenue to Fullarton Street: 4 weeks approximately.

**Phase 4**, Closure: Galloway Avenue, from Shortroods Road to Shortroods Crescent: 4 weeks approximately.

The confirmation dates for phases 4 and 5 will be shown by signs on site on the previous week, to inform regular road users. Phase 5 has been brought forward as shown above.

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into effect at 0001 hours on Saturday, 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2011 and will remain in operation until 2400 hours on Tuesday, 31<sup>st</sup> January 2012 or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access will be maintained to emergency vehicles, but owing to deep excavations it will not be possible to drive through on closed roads.

### **Alternative Routes -**

Alternative routes will be fully signed via other local roads forming the perimeter of the development site.
