Come along to informal drop-in workshops where you'll make beautiful and useful things for your home and garden.

## WAX CARVING FOR BRASS ORNAMENTS

Make your own brass ornament for your home. In this workshop you will find out about the ancient technique of wax casting and use a range of tools to create different effects. By the end of the workshop you will have a 'wax master' which will be sent away and made into a solid metal version of your wax creation.

## **BLOCK PRINTING FOR CUSHIONS**

Design and print a cushion for your sofa. In this workshop you will design and print your own bold pattern using a technique known as block printing. Experimenting with colour and placement, you will print your own fabric that will then be made into a comfy cushion.

#### HAND BUILDING CERAMIC CLOCKS

Sculpt a unique ceramic clock. Working with coloured clay we will make our own wall clocks. In the workshop you will be shown how to stain your own clay with pigment and be taught a variety of techniques to build your own clock shape and design. Your piece will then be fired and fitted with a clock mechanism.

#### **COLOURFUL CONCRETE PLANTERS**

Construct a colourful plant pot for home or garden. In this workshop you'll learn to mix concrete, add pigments and make your own moulds using recycled materials. The concrete planters will be set aside to dry and returned to you finished and ready for your plants.
