

## **Building a garden hut or greenhouse**

### **Guidelines for tenants**

If you wish to apply for permission to build a garden hut or greenhouse, please note the following:

- Your Neighbourhood Office will inform you of its decision to grant permission to build a garden hut or greenhouse within 15 working days of receipt of your application.

- There is a maximum allowed measurement for garden huts and greenhouses:

Length	8 feet (2.4 metres)
Width	6 feet (1.8 metres)
Height	6 feet (1.8 metres) (7 feet 6 inches (2.25 metres) to the highest point)

- Immediate neighbours have no reasonable grounds to object to the structure.
- Huts are used only for storage of garden tools.
- You can only put the garden hut or greenhouse up in your garden area. You must also keep it in a good state of repair.
- You may have to remove the hut or greenhouse if the Neighbourhood Office asks you to, or if you end your tenancy.
