a) Report by Clerk to the Licensing Board – Review of Statement of Licensing Policy for 2018-2022; Responses to Initial Consultation and Further Procedure

- Agree to publish the responses received during the initial, informal consultation;
- That the terms of the proposed draft Statement of Licensing Policy attached at Appendix 6 and the proposed "Issues Paper" attached at Appendix 7, for the purposes of the formal consultation be approved;
- That officers be authorised to consult formally, as required by Section 6 of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, in relation to the said proposed draft Statement of Licensing Policy and "Issues Paper";
- That officers be authorised to consult formally in relation to the identified locality shown at Appendix 4 (Plan 4(a)), as to whether overprovision of all licensed premises or premises of a particular type, exists in respect of the locality, in accordance with Section 7 of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005;

- That officers be authorised, following the formal consultation, to report the responses to that formal consultation to the Board to enable the Board to agree the terms of the Board's new Statement of Licensing Policy, including its assessment of overprovision;
