THE ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984 AND THE ACQUISITION OF LAND (AUTHORISATION PROCEDURE) (SCOTLAND) ACT 1947

THE RENFREWSHIRE COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as “the acquiring authority”) in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 103, 104 and 106 as read with section 110 (2) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 hereby make the following compulsory purchase order:

1. This Order may be cited as “The Renfrewshire Council (Glasgow Airport Investment Area, City Deal) (Number Two) Compulsory Purchase Order 2018”.
2. Subject to the provisions of this Order, the acquiring authority are hereby authorised to purchase compulsorily, for the purposes of (a) the construction of new shared public cycleway / footway and the construction of a new shared public cycleway / footbridge, comprising (i) the construction of a new bridge spanning the Black Cart Water linking Abbotsinch Road, Paisley on the south side to a new shared public cycleway / footway at Greenock Road, Renfrew on the north side of the Black Cart Water; (ii) the construction of a new shared cycleway / footway at the southern end of the said Greenock Road; (iii) the provision of a new toucan crossing for pedestrians and cyclists on the said Greenock Road; (iv) improvements to the junction of Abbotsinch Road / A8 Greenock Road / A8 Inchinnan Road; (v) the landscaping of new roads and cycleways; (vi) drainage of new and existing roads and cycleways; (vii) the provision of improved connections to existing cycleways & core paths; and (b) mitigating any adverse effects which the construction, improvement or use of said roads, bridge, cycleways and footways have or will have on the surroundings of the said roads, bridge, cycleways and footways;

(One) the land which is described in the First Schedule hereto and is delineated in red and coloured pink on the Map signed with reference to this Order and marked “The Map referred to in The Renfrewshire Council (Glasgow Airport Investment Area, City Deal) (Number Two) Compulsory Purchase Order 2018”, and the location of which land is shown on the location plan signed with reference to this Order and marked “The Location Plan referred to in The Renfrewshire Council (Glasgow Airport Investment Area, City Deal) (Number Two) Compulsory Purchase Order 2018”:

(Two) the servitude rights over the land which is described in the First Schedule hereto and is delineated in red and coloured blue on the said Map, and the location of which land is shown on the said Location Plan; and

(Three) the temporary servitude rights over the land which is described in the First Schedule hereto and is delineated in red and coloured green on the said Map and the location of which land is shown on the said Location Plan.

3. In relation to the foregoing purchase, section 70 of the Railways Clauses Consolidation (Scotland) Act 1845 and sections 71 to 78 of that Act as originally enacted and not as amended for certain purposes by section 15 of the Mines (Working Facilities and Support) Act 1923, are hereby incorporated with the enactment under which the said purchase is authorised, subject to the modifications that references in the said section to the company shall be construed as references to the acquiring authority and references to the railway or works shall be construed as references to the land authorised to be purchased and any buildings or works constructed or to be constructed thereon.
4. The registration of a conveyance, as defined in section 106 (5) of the Title Conditions (Scotland) Act 2003, in implement of this Order, shall not extinguish the real burdens or servitudes described in the Second Schedule hereto.
