<ol> <li>Council officers will endeavour to provide assistance to enquiries in relation to licensing issues.</li> <li>It is normal practice for Officers to ask for improvements, should there be any required. Where there are several items in need of attention and they are considered to be of significant importance then a re-inspection may be carried out. Should there be repeated failures to carry out required improvements then licences may be refused or revoked.</li> </ol>
