Wheel chair access is available to the extra wide rear door of the lounge area which is accessed from a small paved incline leading from the pathway to the front of the Club. Internally the Club is on a single level and there is easy access for disabled persons throughout.

All seating areas within the Club are single moveable chairs which can be positioned to assist disabled persons or moved to accommodate wheel chair users throughout. Similarly tables within the lounge and function hall can be adjusted where necessary. Disabled toilet facilities are installed in the reception foyer adjacent to the function hall.
