3. The Ladies locker room entrance which gives access to the locker room and office area and also connects to the lounge

Club House has a disabled toilet in the foyer on the way in from the main entrance. In the lounge there is suitable height tables to allow for use to eat and drink. There is also access to the front of the lounge via patio doors to an area for sitting outside.
