

## **Keeping pigeons & putting up a pigeon Loft**

### **Guidelines for tenants**

For permission to keep pigeons and put up a pigeon loft please note the following:

- Your Neighbourhood Office will inform you of its decision to grant permission within 15 days of receipt of your application.
- You must be a member of a recognised pigeon society and have proof of your current membership.
- You must get permission from your neighbours.
- You must keep the loft clean and in a good state of repair.
- You must not allow the pigeons to annoy your neighbours or cause a nuisance.
- The maximum allowed size of any loft is: height 4 metres, length 3 metres, width 2.5 meters.
- If permission is granted then at a later date you end your tenancy, you must undertake to remove the pigeon loft and reinstate the ground, all to the satisfaction of the Neighbourhood Office.
- If you fail to do this the work will be carried out by the Council, and you will be responsible for the costs.
