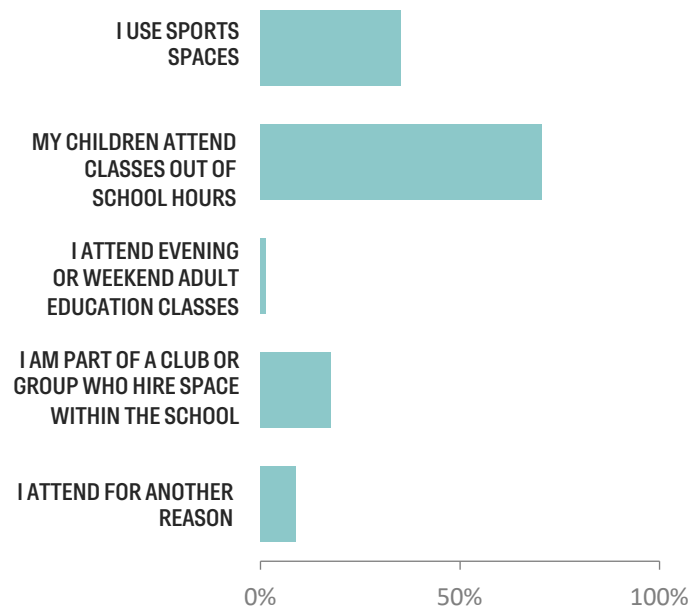

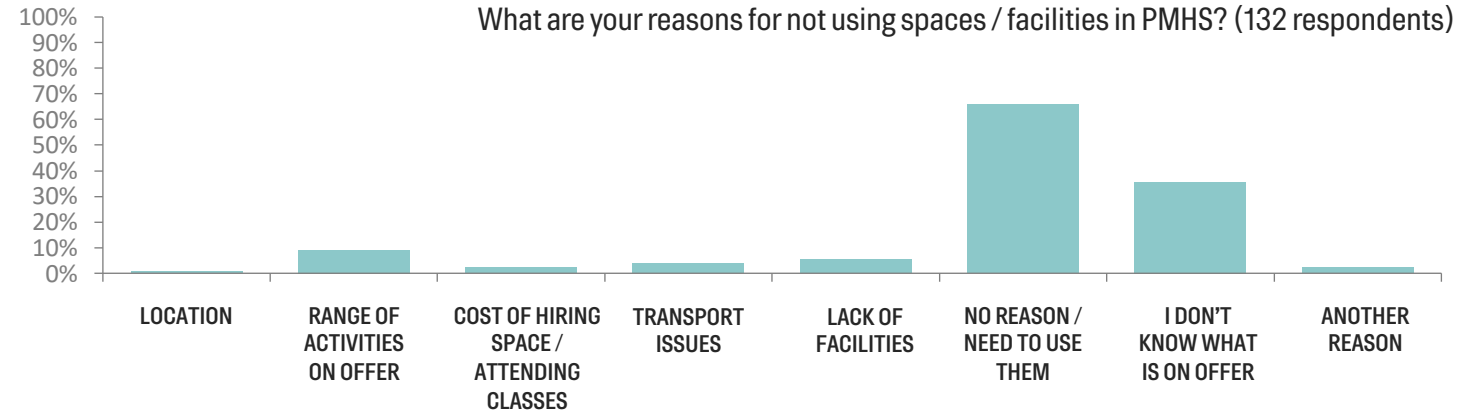

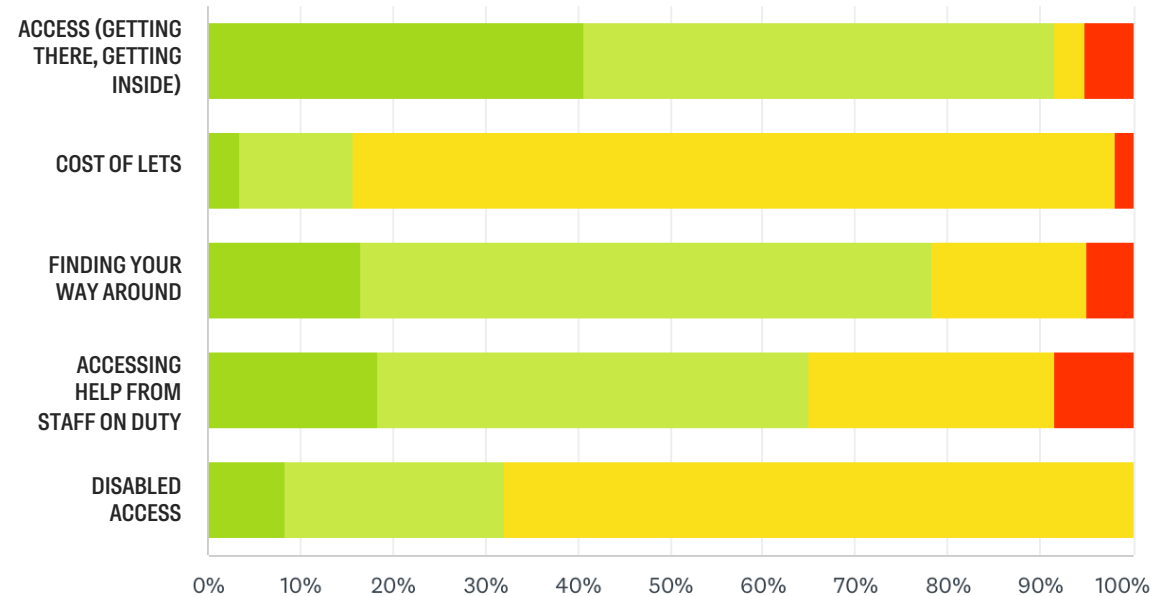
What do you use spaces / facilities in PMHS for?

How do you rate the current building in terms of:

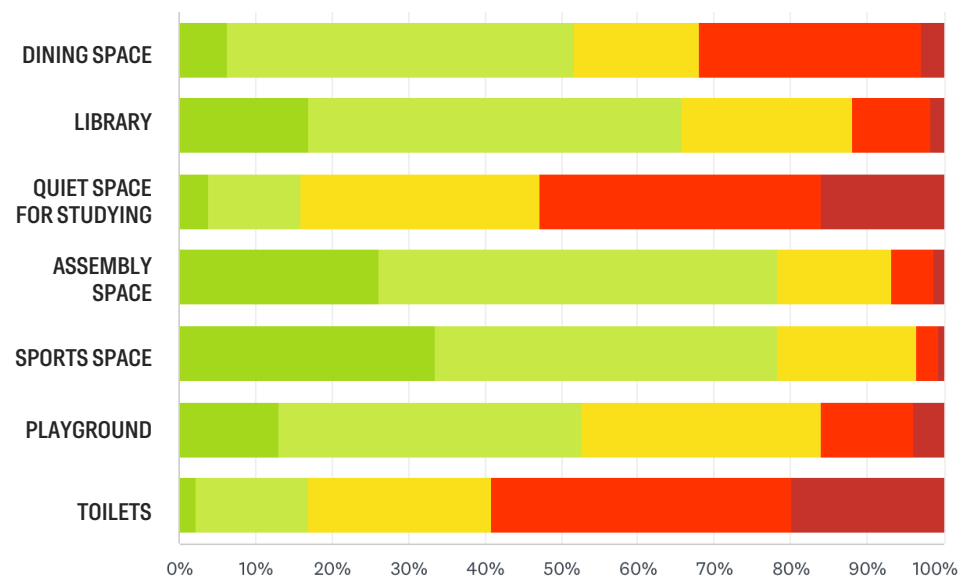

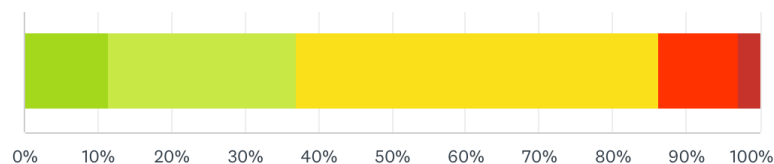

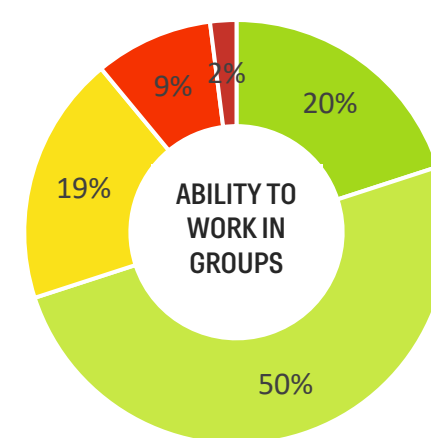

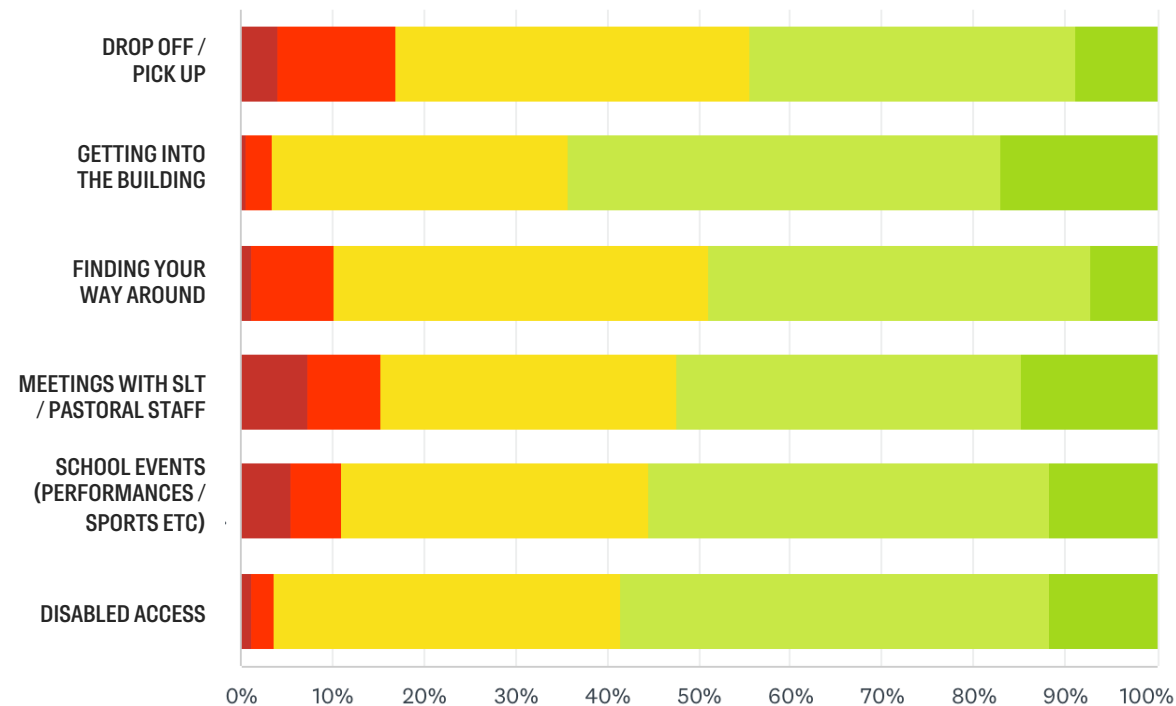

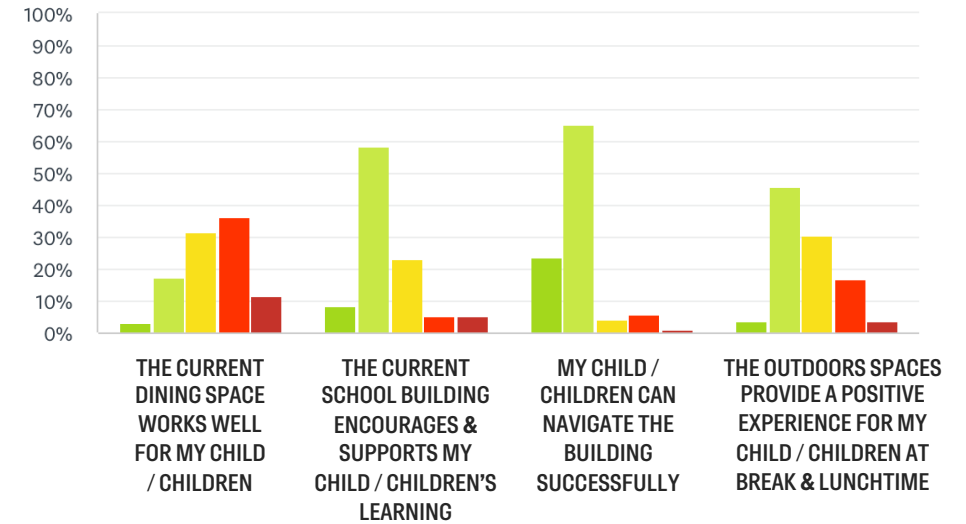

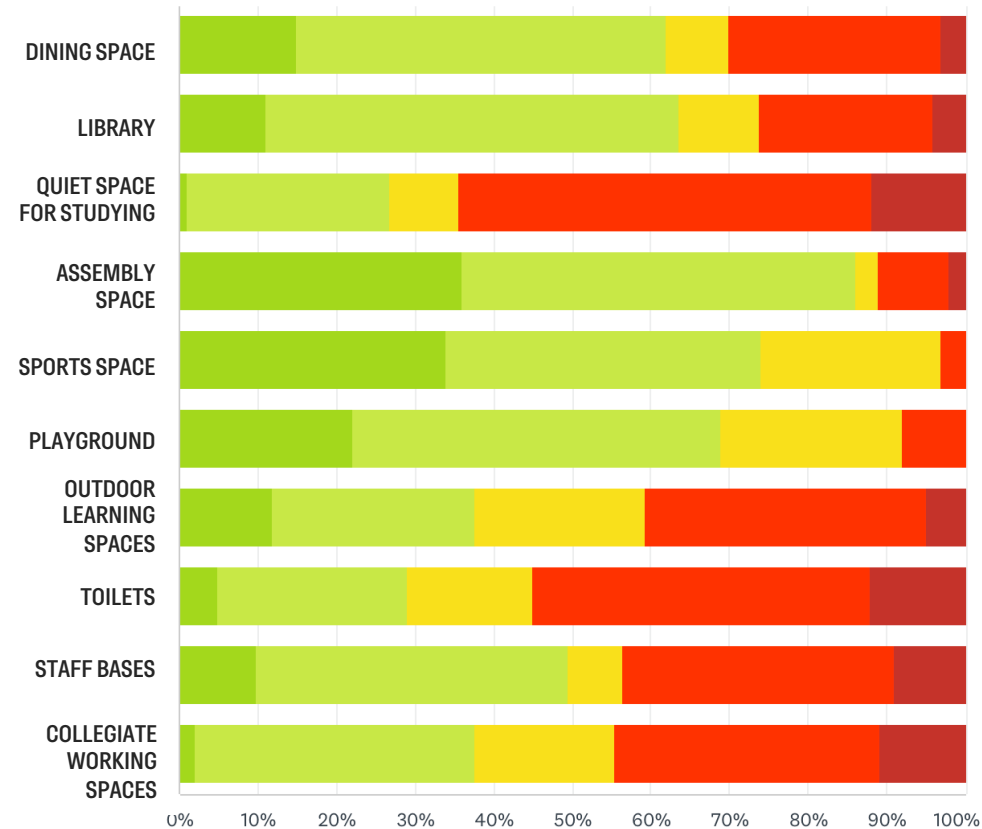

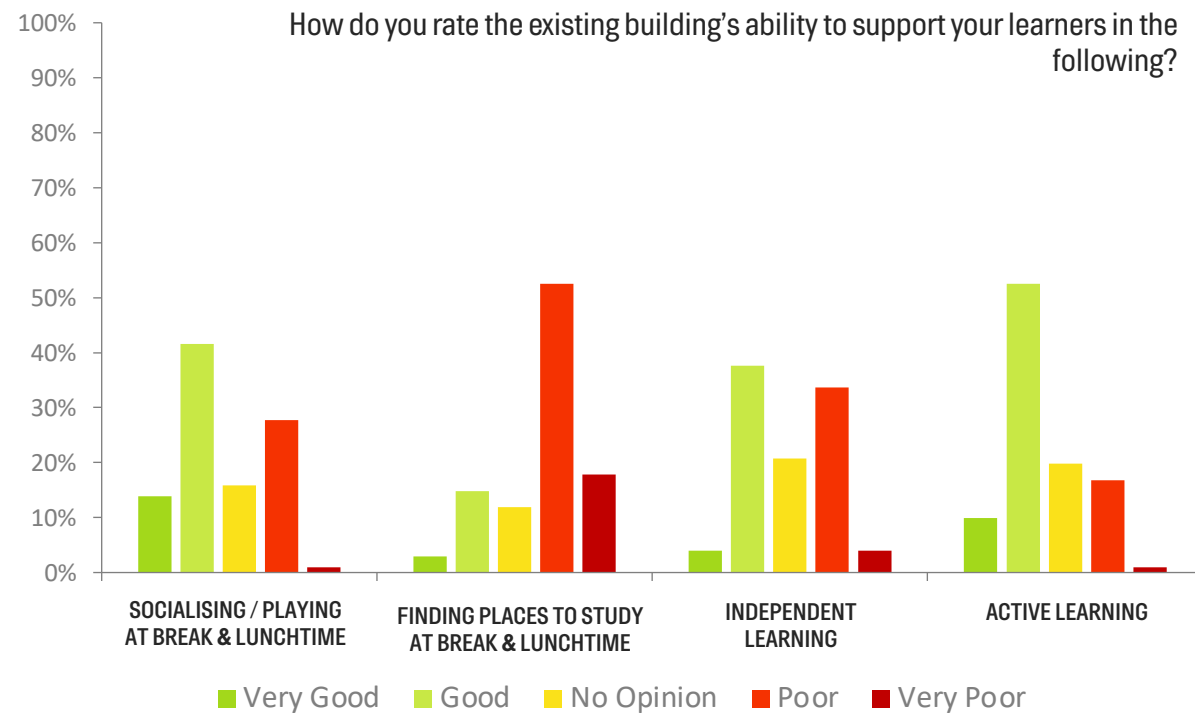

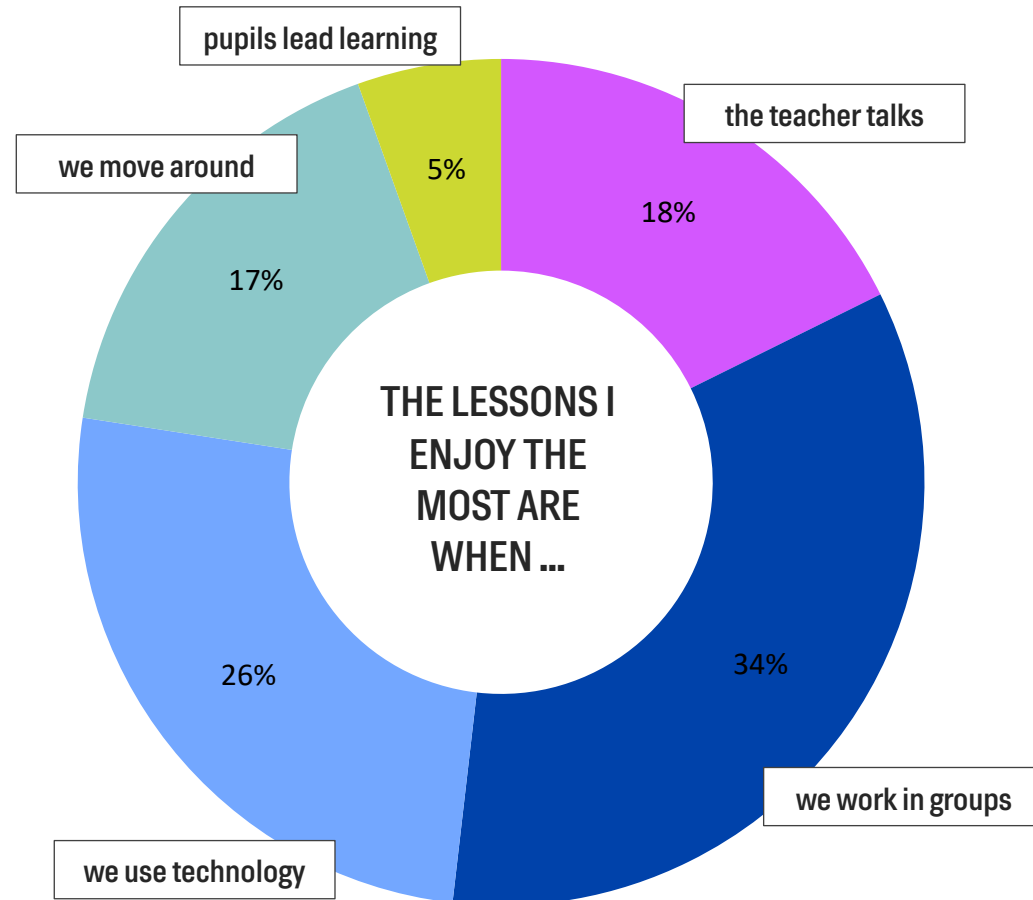

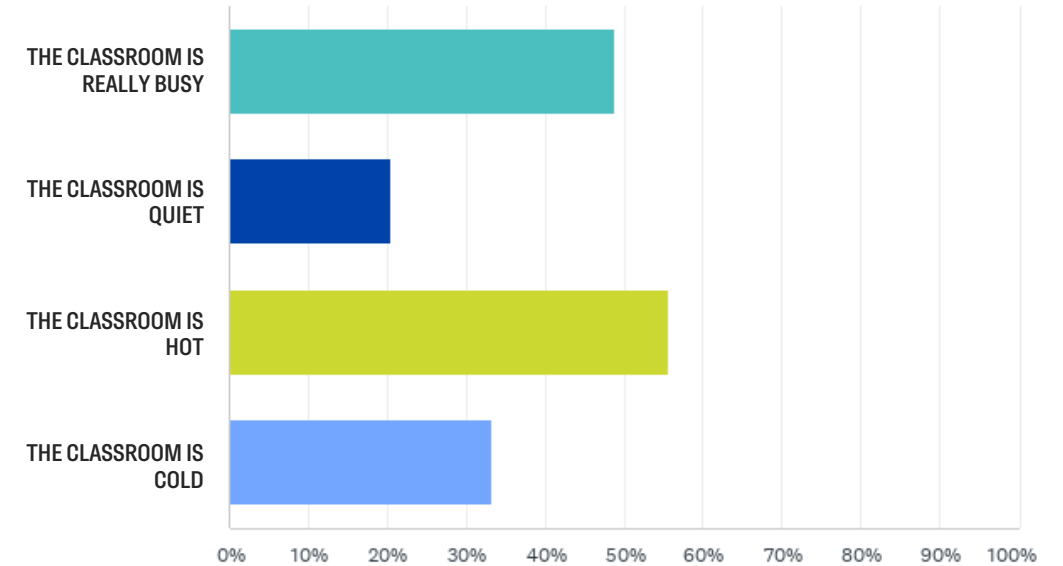

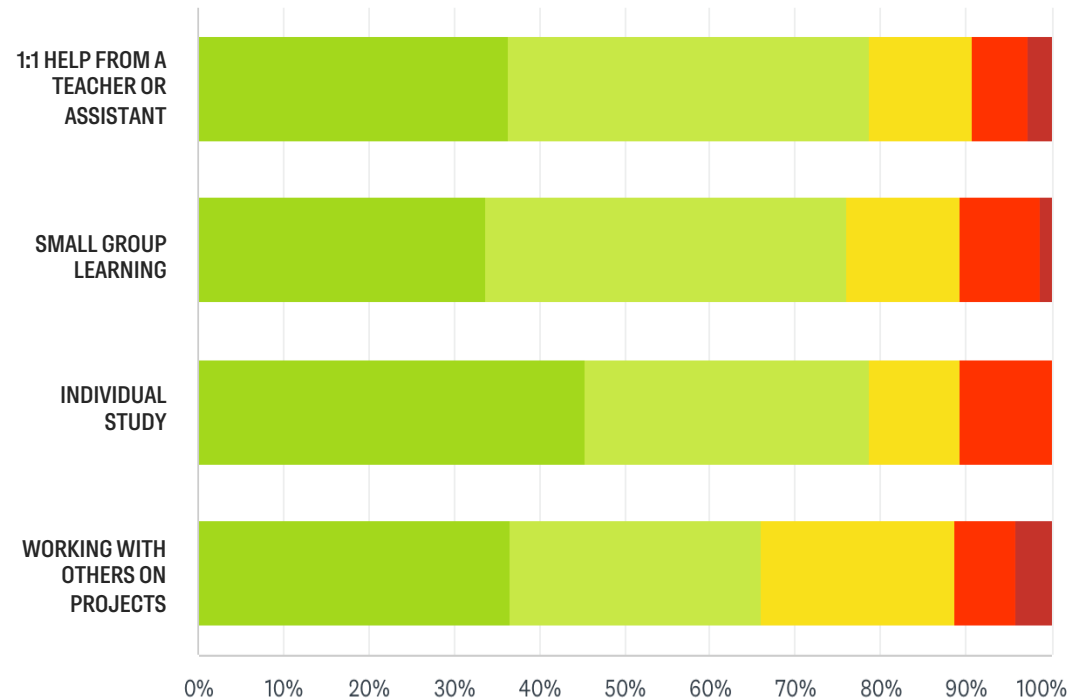

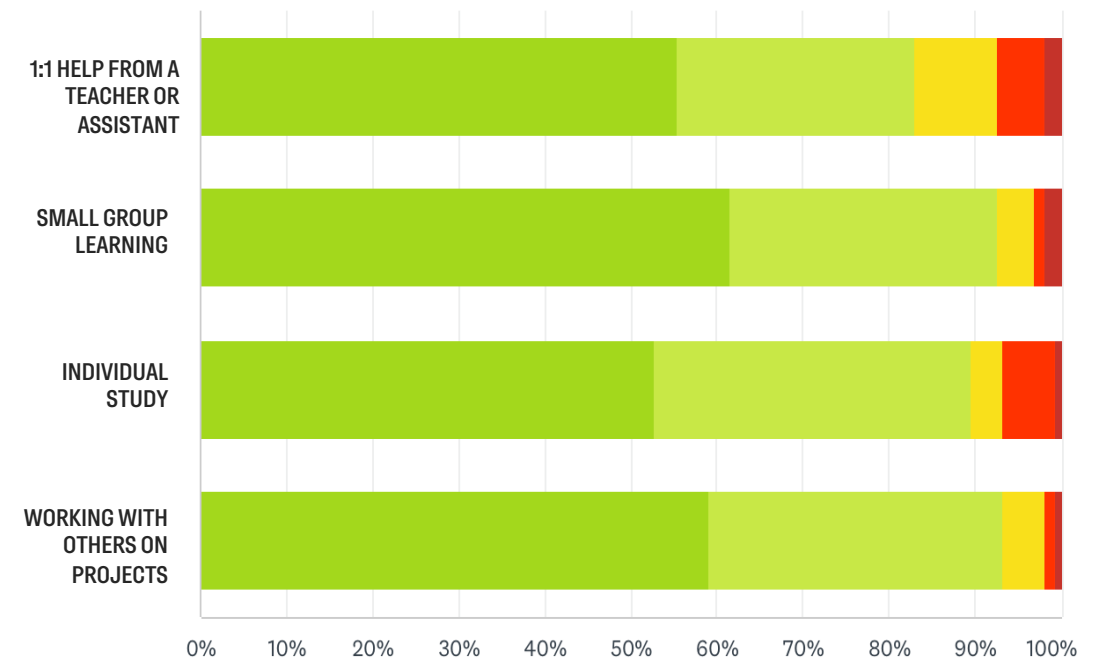

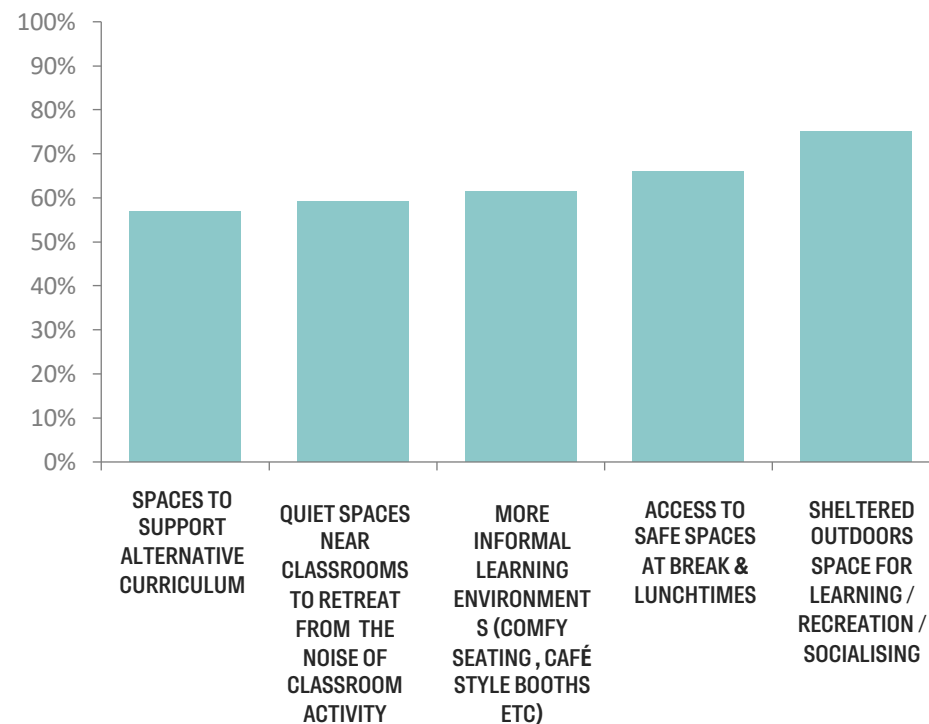


How useful do you think breakout space outside classrooms is for the following?

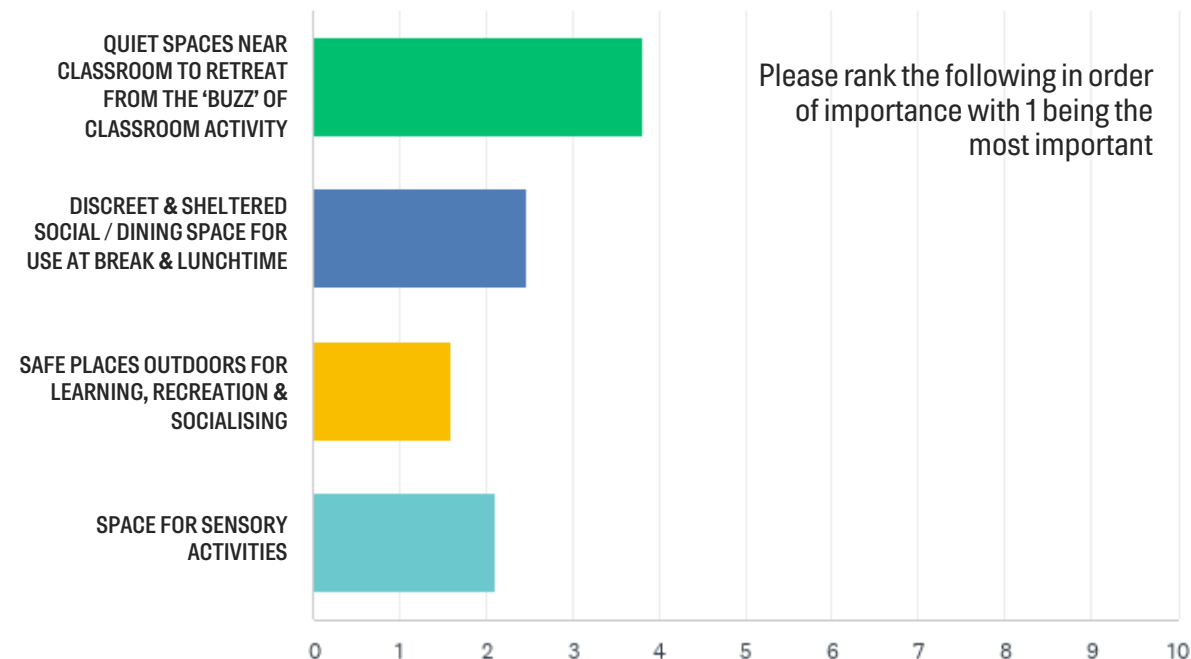

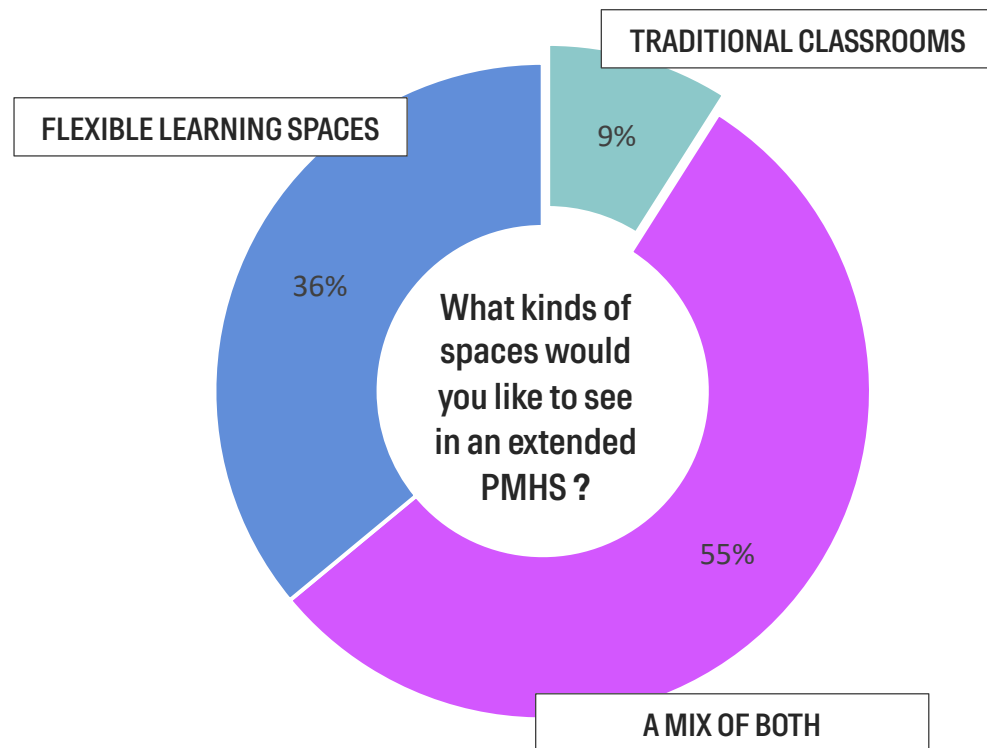

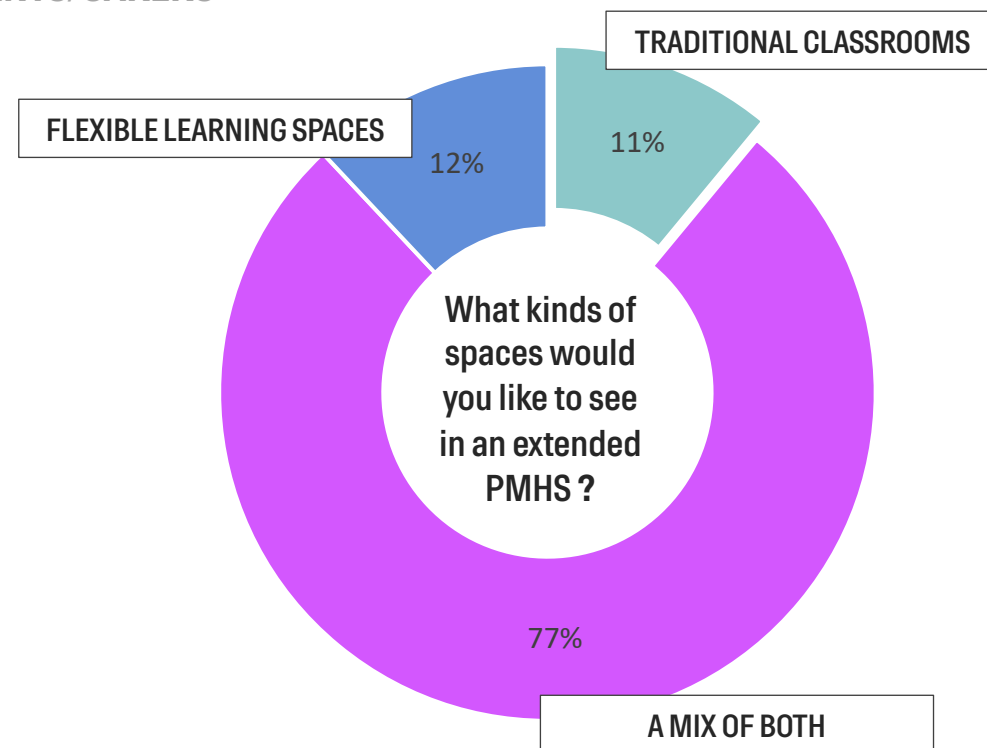

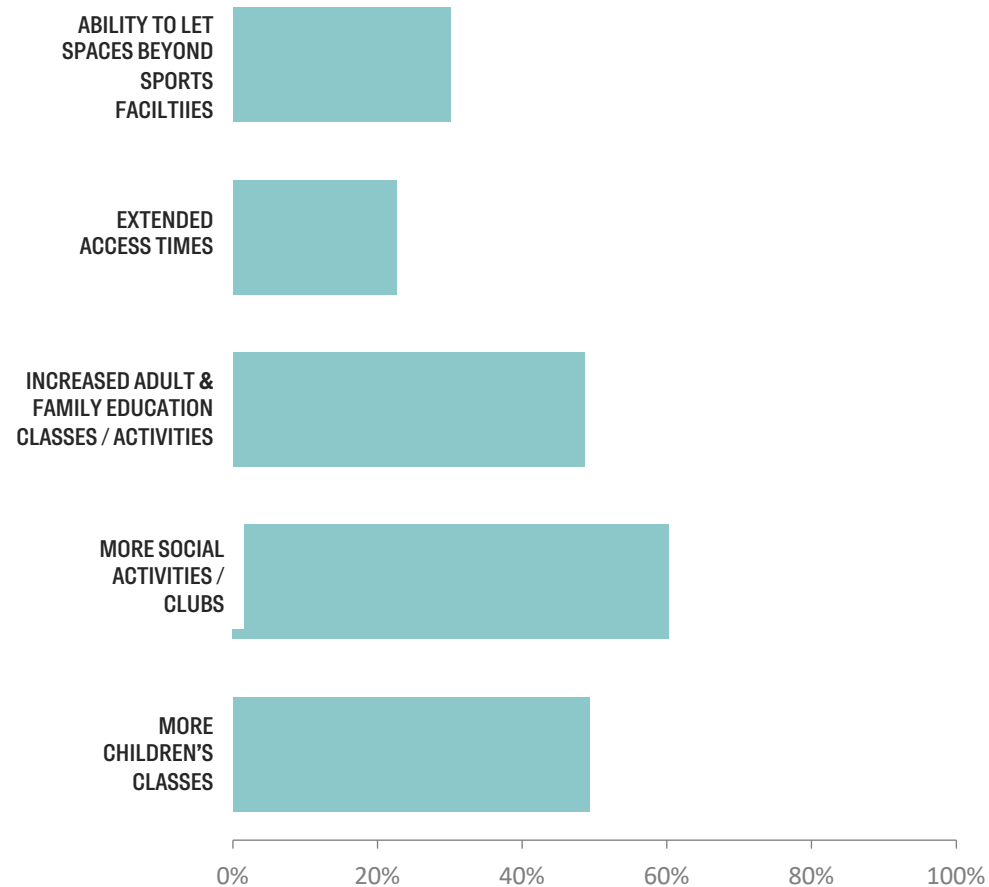
