

**CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982  
APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT LICENCE  
PROPOSED SMALL CIRCUS (NO ANIMALS) AT  
BARSHAW PARK, PAISLEY, PA1 3LT**

NOTICE is hereby given that an application for a public entertainment licence has been submitted to Renfrewshire Council by **Tony Hopkins Events CIC** in respect of a proposed **Small Circus (no animals)** which falls under the category of **Circus** at **Barshaw Park, Paisley, PA1 3LT**. The proposed times of operation are:

**2 October to 4 October 2024 from 3.00pm until 9.00pm**

**5 October 2024 from 2.00pm until 9.00pm**

**6 October 2024 from 12.30pm until 5.00pm.**

- (a) is in writing;
- (b) specifies the grounds of the objection or, as the case may be, the nature of the representation;
- (c) specifies the name and address of the person making it;
- (d) is signed by him or on his behalf (the Council is now able to accept an objection electronically for this type of application, with an electronic signature, as above, emailed into [licensingadmin@renfrewshire.gov.uk](mailto:licensingadmin@renfrewshire.gov.uk); and
- (e) was made to them by **4 September 2024**.

It shall be competent for a licensing authority to entertain an objection or representation received by them before they take a final decision upon the application if they are satisfied that there is sufficient reason why it was not made in the time required as in accordance with the above.

An objection or representation shall be made if it is delivered by hand within the timescale stated above or posted (by registered or recorded delivery post) so that in the normal course of post it might be expected to be delivered to the licensing authority within that timescale.
