

**CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982
APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT LICENCE
PROPOSED FUNFAIR, PAISLEY TOWN CENTRE**

NOTICE is hereby given that an application for a temporary public entertainment licence has been submitted to Renfrewshire Council by **Irvin Stringfellow, 4 Priorwood Place, Glasgow, G13 1GN** in respect of a **Funfair** which falls under the category of **Fairground** at **Paisley Town Centre – East End Park, Lagoon North Car Park, County Square, Gilmour Street, Bridge Street, Bridge Street Car Park and High Street (including an area near the Cenotaph)**. The proposed times of operation are **from 14 October 2024, Monday to Sunday, 10.00am to 10.00pm, on School Holidays, Public Holidays, any Friday Saturday or Sunday and additionally the following events: Halloween Festival, Sma' Shot Day, Paisley Christmas Lights, Food and Drink Festival. Permission to attend will be at the discretion of the Events Manager.**

Any objection or representation relating to the application shall be entertained by the licensing authority if, but only if, the objection or representation-

- (a) is in writing;
- (b) specifies the grounds of the objection or, as the case may be, the nature of the representation;
- (c) specifies the name and address of the person making it;
- (d) is signed by him or on his behalf (the Council is now able to accept an objection electronically for this type of application, with an electronic signature, as above, emailed into licensingadmin@renfrewshire.gov.uk; and
- (e) was made to them by **9 October 2024**.

It shall be competent for a licensing authority to entertain an objection or representation received by them before they take a final decision upon the application if they are satisfied that there is sufficient reason why it was not made in the time required as in accordance with the above.

An objection or representation shall be made if it is delivered by hand within the timescale stated above or posted (by registered or recorded delivery post) so that in the normal course of post it might be expected to be delivered to the licensing authority within that timescale.
